

# **General Description**

The TriQuint T1G4012036-FS is a 120 W Peak (24 W Avg.) ( $P_{3dB}$ ) discrete GaN on SiC HEMT which operates from DC to 3.5 GHz. The device is constructed with TriQuint's proven TQGaN25HV process, which features advanced field plate techniques to optimize power and efficiency at high drain bias operating conditions. This optimization can potentially lower system costs in terms of fewer amplifier line-ups and lower thermal management costs.

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



Maximum Channel Temperature vs. Pulse Width






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## Load Pull Smith Charts (1, 2)






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# Performance Over Temperature (1, 2)

Performance measured in TriQuint's 3.1 GHz to 3.5 GHz Evaluation Board at 3 dB compression.







Performance at 3 dB Compression



## **Application Circuit**



### **Bias-up Procedure**

Set gate voltage (V<sub>G</sub>) to -5.0V

Set drain voltage (V<sub>D</sub>) to 36 V

Slowly increase V<sub>G</sub> until quiescent I<sub>D</sub> is 360 mA.

Apply RF signal

### **Bias-down Procedure**

Turn off RF signal

Turn off  $V_{\text{D}}$  and wait 1 second to allow drain capacitor dissipation


Turn off V<sub>G</sub>



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## **Evaluation Board Layout**

Top RF layer is 0.020" thick Rogers RO4350B,  $\varepsilon_r = 3.48$ . The pad pattern shown has been developed and tested for optimized assembly at TriQuint Semiconductor. The PCB land pattern has been developed to accommodate lead and package tolerances.








