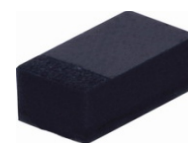

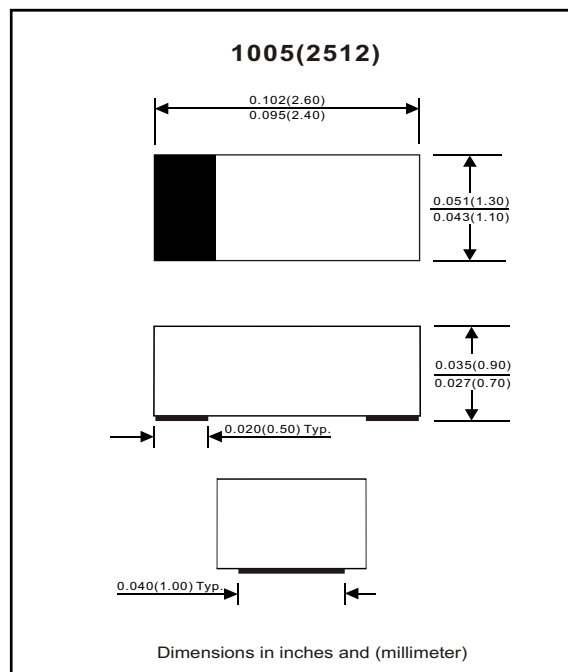


Features

- Low forward voltage.

- Extremely thin/leadless package.
- Majority carrier conduction.

- Terminals: Gold plated, solderable per MIL-STD-750, method 2026.
- Polarity: Indicated by cathode band.
- Mounting position: Any
- Weight: 0.006 gram(approx.).

Fig. 1 - Forward characteristics

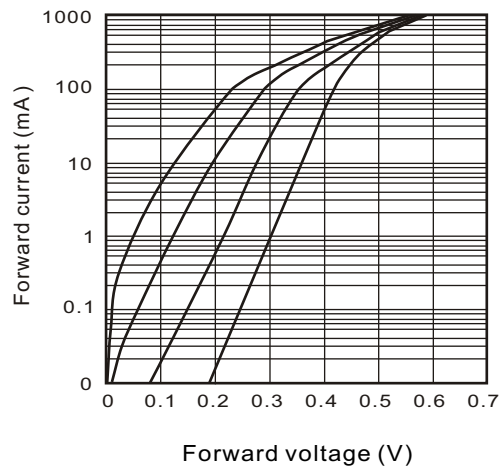


Fig. 2 - Reverse characteristics

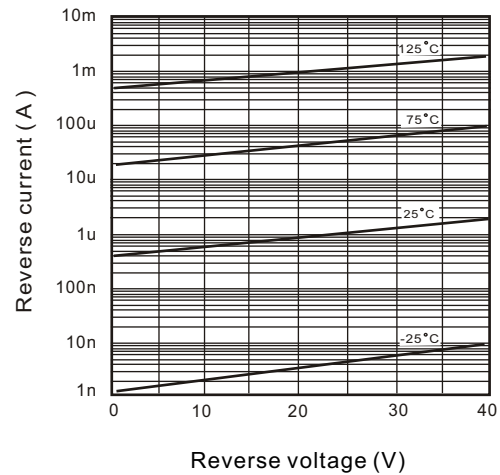


Fig. 3 - Capacitance between terminals characteristics

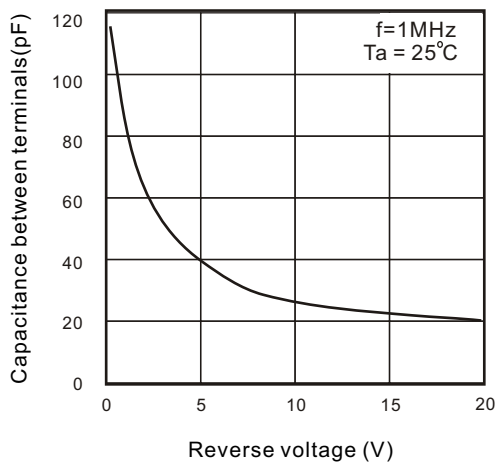


Fig. 4 - Current derating curve
