Dear Distributor,

Over the next several months, Cornell Dubilier will standardize its snap-in capacitor lines by implementing the following:

- All standard capacitors will have an insulator end disk at the top of the capacitor, regardless of voltage (lower voltage parts currently do not require end disks).
- The standard sleeve color for all snap-in series will change to black. (Some series, such as our 380 types currently have blue sleeving)

All part numbers will remain the same. There will not be any changes made to the electrical or mechanical specifications or part performance.

Please be advised that this transition will take roughly 9 months to complete. Until such time that inventory is depleted, it is possible that you will receive mixed shipments: some PNs with blue sleeving, others with black, some with end disks, some without.
