

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Declaration

REACH is a new European Union regulation concerning the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorization and restriction of **C**hemicals. It became effective on 1st June 2007 and replaces a number of European Directives and Regulations with a single system.

Murata Power Solutions wishes to assure its business partners that it will take all appropriate precautions to prevent disruption to business and to ensure continuity of product supply to its customers. Specifically, we confirm that;

1. We are aware of the REACH regulations; the potential implications for our business; and our obligations to ensure business continuity.
2. In our EU operation, we do not manufacture or import any substances that require registration under REACH regulations.
3. None of our products are intended to release any chemical.
4. Based on estimate weight of components as well as material data from component and material suppliers, our product does not contain any of SVHC chemicals candidates as published by European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) on October 9, 2008 at above 0.1% by weight of the article (our products).
5. We have or will contact suppliers who supply us with substances that may likely require registration under REACH regulations to request confirmation that the chemicals of concerns were either registered or they have requested their downstream suppliers to do so.
6. We will take appropriate action in response to any to business risks arising through supplier failure to co-operate and support us in this project.
7. We will do our utmost to ensure that continuity of supply of our products will not be adversely affected by issues arising from the REACH regulations.
