PMA: DASyLab End-Of-Life Notification

Transitioning to a Unified NI Software Platform for Data Acquisition and Analysis

Executive Summary:

DASyLab, a graphical data acquisition and analysis software, will now be offered by measX, an NI partner, with NI officially announcing the End-of-Life (EOL). This decision aligns with our strategy to consolidate and modernize our software portfolio, focusing on scalable, integrated platforms such as NI LabVIEW, FlexLogger, TestStand, VeriStand, and DIAdem. Customers are encouraged to transition to these supported tools for all new designs and ongoing projects.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

DASYLab will now be exclusively offered by measX GmbH & Co. KG (“measX”), an NI partner. This transition ensures customers receive the best possible support and a simplified path for customizations and licensing.

DASYLab has served the test and measurement community for more than three decades. Originally developed by DATALOG GmbH and later supported by NI, measX, and Digilent, it became a trusted solution for users who prefer an intuitive, no-code, drag-and-drop environment for building data acquisition and control applications.

As part of our broader alignment of the Digilent software portfolio, NI and Digilent will no longer offer DASYLab. Existing customers may continue using the software without interruption, and measX will now provide all licensing, updates, downloads, and technical support.

For customers wanting to move onto NI’s modern platform, tools such as LabVIEW and its companion products provide deeper hardware integration, broader protocol support, and scalable architectures for everything from basic logging to automated test and real-time systems.

WHY?

We are shifting DASYLab to measX:

- To **provide the best support** to existing DASYLab customers.
- To **streamline our software offerings** and reduce overlap across tools.
- To **focus investment** on platforms that offer deeper integration with NI hardware, modern user experiences, and long-term scalability.
- To **simplify the customer journey** by aligning use cases with best-fit NI software solutions that are actively supported and developed.

HOW?

Licensing

No new DASYLab licenses will be sold by NI and Digilent after the EOL date. Existing licenses will remain valid, but no new activations or upgrades will be issued by NI or Digilent beyond the EOL support window. New licenses may be acquired from measX, instead.
