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1. General description

The 74LVC04A provides six inverting buffers. Inputs can be driven from either 3.3 V or 5 V devices. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed 3.3 V and 5 V applications.



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



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





Fig 8. Package outline SOT108-1 (SO14)

Fig 9. Package outline SOT337-1 (SSOP14)

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



Fig 10. Package outline SOT402-1 (TSSOP14)
