




Figure 7. Forward Power Dissipation




Figure 8. Thermal Response, Junction-to-Ambient (20 mm<sup>2</sup> pad)


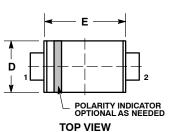


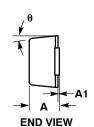
Figure 9. Thermal Response, Junction-to-Ambient (1 in<sup>2</sup> pad)

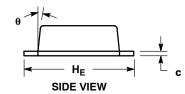


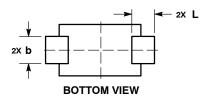

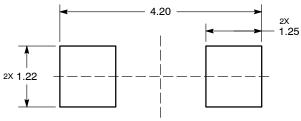
