




Figure 3. On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

Figure 4. On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and **Gate Voltage**




Figure 5. On-Resistance Variation with **Temperature**




Figure 6. Drain-to-Source Leakage Current vs. Voltage




Figure 7. Capacitance Variation

Figure 8. Gate-to-Source Voltage vs. Total Charge




Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation vs. Gate Resistance

Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current




Figure 11. Maximum Rated Forward Biased Safe Operating Area





Figure 13. Thermal Response
