




Figure 1. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 2. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 3. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs.
Collector Current





Figure 4. Base Emitter Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 5. Saturation Region

Figure 6. Temperature Coefficients




Figure 7. Capacitances




Figure 8. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 9. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 10. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs.

Figure 11. Base Emitter Voltage vs. Collector Current





Figure 12. Current Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Collector Current




Figure 13. Saturation Region

Figure 14. Temperature Coefficients




Figure 15. Capacitances




Figure 16. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 17. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 18. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs.

Figure 19. Base Emitter Voltage vs. Collector Current





Figure 20. Current Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Collector Current




Figure 21. Saturation Region

Figure 22. Temperature Coefficients




Figure 23. Capacitances




Figure 24. Safe Operating Area
