For standard cable colors other than Off White, add suffix BL (Black), BU (Blue), GR (Green), RD (Red), YL (Yellow), OR (Orange) or VL (Violet) after the M in the part number. For example, the part number for a blue 15 meter patch cord is UTPSP15MBUY.


