



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


Fig.1 DC current gain vs. collector current

Fig.3 Base-emitter saturation voltage vs.collector current




Fig.4 Grounded emitter propagation characteristics




Fig.5 Gain bandwidth product vs. emitter current




Fig.6 Collector output capacitance vs. collector-base voltage Emitter input capacitance vs. emitter-base voltage
