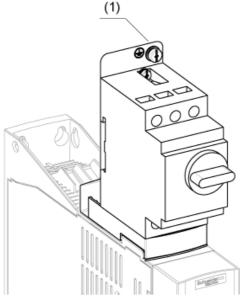

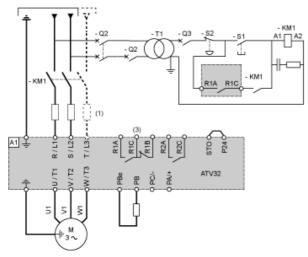

Single or Three-phase Power Supply - Diagram with Line Contactor

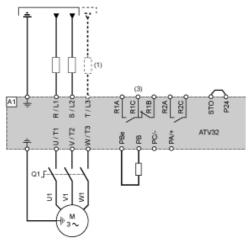

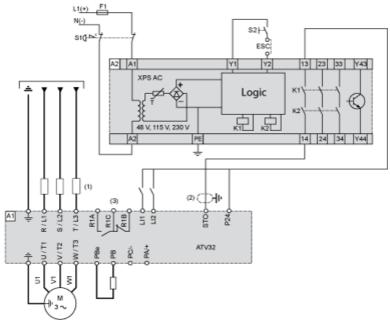

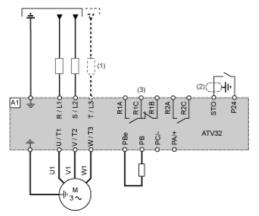

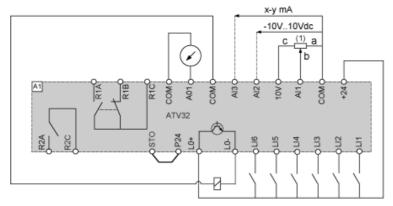

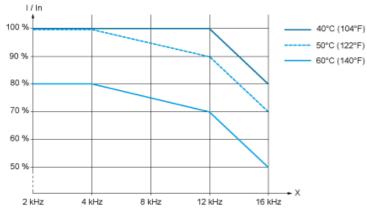
Control Connection Diagram in Source Mode

Derating curve for the nominal drive current (In) as a function of temperature and switching frequency.

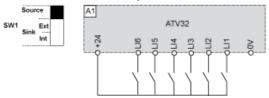

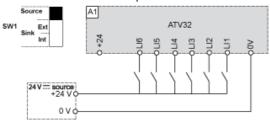

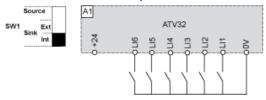

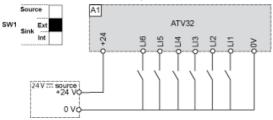
Switch SW1 set to "Source" position and use of an external power supply for the LIs
