






Fig. 6.2.1 Switching Time Test Circuit




Fig. 7.1 Marking




Fig. 8.1 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.3 ID - VGS




Fig. 8.5 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - I<sub>D</sub>




Fig. 8.2 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.4 VDS - VGS




Fig. 8.6 IDR - VDS






Fig. 8.7 V<sub>(BR)DSS</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 8.9 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 8.11 Capacitance - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.8 V<sub>th</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 8.10 Dynamic Input/Output Characteristics




Fig. 8.12  $Q_{oss}$  -  $V_{DS}$ 






Fig. 8.13  $r_{th}$  -  $t_w$  (Guaranteed Maximum)




Fig. 8.14 P<sub>D</sub> - T<sub>a</sub> (Guaranteed Maximum)




Fig. 8.15 P<sub>D</sub> - T<sub>c</sub> (Guaranteed Maximum)





Fig. 8.16 Safe Operating Area (Guaranteed Maximum)
