








Fig. 8.1 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.3  $I_D$  -  $V_{GS}$ 




Fig. 8.5 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - I<sub>D</sub>




Fig. 8.2 I<sub>D</sub> - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.4  $V_{DS}$  -  $V_{GS}$ 




Fig. 8.6 R<sub>DS(ON)</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>






Fig. 8.7 IDR - VDS





Fig. 8.9 Vth - Ta




Fig. 8.8 Capacitance - V<sub>DS</sub>




Fig. 8.10 Dynamic Input/Output Characteristics




Fig. 8.12 P<sub>D</sub> - T<sub>c</sub> (Guaranteed Maximum)






Fig. 8.13 r<sub>th</sub> - t<sub>w</sub> (Guaranteed Maximum)




Fig. 8.14 Safe Operating Area (Guaranteed Maximum)




