




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Q<sub>g</sub> - Total Gate Charge (nC) **Gate Charge** 






T<sub>J</sub> - Temperature (°C) Typical Drain-source Brakdown Voltage vs. Junction Temperature








