## 1. General description

Bidirectional ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection diode in very small SOD323 (SC-76) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package designed to protect one signal line from the damage caused by ESD and other transients.




Fig. 1. 8/20 μs pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5




Fig. 2. ESD pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-2






Fig. 3. Peak pulse power as a function of exponential pulse duration; typical values

Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typcial values






Fig. 6. Relative variation of reverse leakage current as a function of junction temperature; typical values



## 10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of one bidirectional data line from surge pulses and ESD damage. The device is suitable on lines where the signal polarities are both positive and negative with respect to ground.



#### Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

- 1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
- 2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
- **3.** Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
- 4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
- 5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
- 6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
- 7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
- 8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.





Fig. 9. Package outline SOD323
