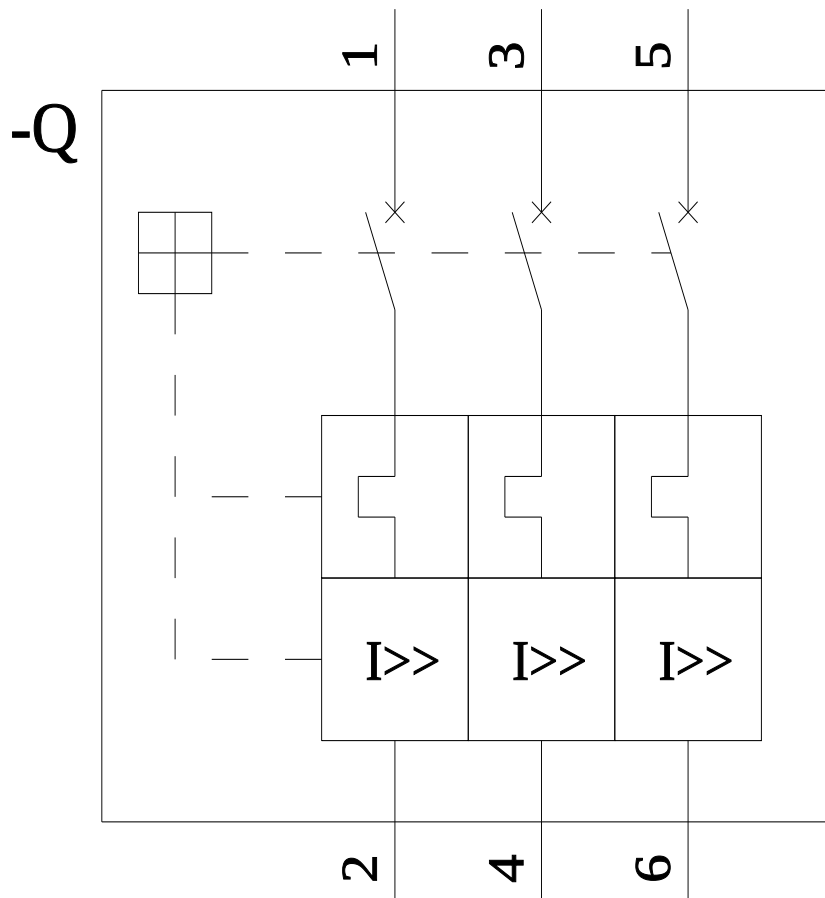

The diagrams show the production and decay of a Z boson in a quark-antiquark annihilation process. In all three diagrams, a quark (q) and an antiquark (q-bar) annihilate into a Z boson, which then decays into a lepton (l) and an antilepton (l-bar). The production of the Z boson occurs via a gluon exchange (g) in all three diagrams. The difference between the diagrams lies in the decay of the Z boson into a lepton pair. In diagram 1, the Z boson decays into a lepton pair via a Z boson exchange. In diagram 3, the Z boson decays into a lepton pair via a Z boson exchange. In diagram 5, the Z boson decays into a lepton pair via a Z boson exchange.

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
