Berlin Calling: Formula E Hits Tempelhof for High-Stakes Rounds 7 & 8

Berlin, Germany – Formula E returns to one of its most iconic venues this weekend as the championship lands at Tempelhof Airport for Rounds 7 and 8 of Season 12. A constant on the calendar since the very beginning, Berlin hosts its 12th edition—once again setting the stage for a defining chapter in the season.

Compact, raw, and relentlessly technical, the 2.374 km Tempelhof circuit weaves through 15 turns laid out on the venue’s distinctive concrete surface. Grip is limited, margins are tight, and there’s little room for error—making it a true test of control, efficiency, and race intelligence.

Saturday brings an added layer of unpredictability with the Pit Boost format, pushing teams to rethink strategy and execution in real time.

Berlin marks a critical waypoint in the championship. As the second European event following Madrid Jarama and just ahead of the showcase race in Monaco Monte-Carlo, it anchors a decisive stretch in the calendar. With the season approaching its midpoint, every point carries added weight.

On track, the DS PENSKE drivers are ready to rise to the challenge. For Maximilian Günther, the Berlin E-Prix carries special meaning as a home race, with the energy and support of the German fans set to provide an extra boost on familiar ground. On the other side of the garage, Taylor arrives with clear intent—eager to convert pace into a breakthrough result and secure a first podium finish with the team. Both drivers know that Tempelhof rewards commitment and precision, and this weekend offers a prime opportunity to deliver.

From its industrial backdrop to its unforgiving layout, Tempelhof consistently delivers racing at its most intense.

Don't miss the action - the race will start at 4:05pm local time this Saturday 2 and Sunday 3 May, 2026.
